By this Order, I intend to dispose of an appeal filed by Shah Wali, Office No. 5, Asad Building, Dr. Bano Road, Quetta against decision of Election Commission of Chamber of Commerce and Industry Quetta before the Regulator of Trade Organizations under Rule 18(13) of Trade Organizations Rules, 2013.

2. Brief facts of the appeal are that nomination forms of appellant and his group members were rejected by the Election Commission of Chamber of Commerce and Industry Quetta on the ground that their signatures did not match with the specimen submitted by them to the QCC&I. He further stated that nomination papers of his opponents were accepted and no objections whatsoever were raised by the Commission.

3. In order to decide fate of the appeal, notices of personal hearing, fixed for 6-9-2013, were served to Secretary General and Election Commission of QCC&I, Baluchistan.

4. During the personal hearing, appellant reiterated the stance already taken in his appeal. The Secretary General and member of Election Commission stated that nomination paper of appellant was rejected due to difference in signature. They further stated that appellant cannot file an appeal on behalf of other members as he was not an aggrieved person, nor he was in possession of authorization letters from the persons whose case he was pleading before the Regulator of Trade Organizations. The appellant conceded during the personal hearing that he had three different signatures.

5. In order to ascertain the veracity of his appeal, hearing of subject appeal was adjourned to 10-9-2013 and Secretary General QCC&I, Baluchistan was directed to re-appear on the above mentioned date along with relevant record. The appellant appeared on 10-09-2013, however, the Secretary General, QCC&I had sent a fax message that flights were not available, hence the hearing may be adjourned to 11-09-2013. Accordingly, the hearing was adjourned to 11-9-2013 after informing the appellants.

6. The respondents appeared on 11-9-2013, whereas appellant did not show up.

**ORDER:-**

7. After perusing the record of the case and taking into consideration the relevant provision of law, this forum is of the view that appellant cannot file an appeal on behalf of other group members as authorization letters were not furnished by him to this forum. Furthermore, he failed to appear on 11-9-2013 to plead his case which shows that he is not interested in the instant appeal and the same has been instituted to halt the electoral process. Hence, instant appeal is dismissed on account of non-prosecution.
