**ORDER:-**

By this order I intend to dispose off an appeal filed by Mr. Wali Mohammad of Quetta filed before the Regulator of Trade Organizations.

2. The appellant in his aforesaid appeal had alleged that he and three other candidates whom he also represent as authorized person, had not withdrawn their candidatures for contesting election for the membership of Executive Committee of Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Quetta for which polling was scheduled to be held on 14-09-2013. Whereas, the Election Commission announced the results on 12-09-2013 in violation of the Election Schedule, meaning thereby that they were willfully deprived from participation in the election.

3. In order to dispose of the appeal, a personal hearing for 27-09-2013 was fixed. However, the President of Chamber of Commerce and Industry, Quetta visited my office on 25-09-2013 and requested that early hearing in the matter may be held as it was very difficult for the Chamber to send four persons from Quetta on a very short notice received from the DGTO Office by fax, particularly when flight schedule was uncertain and the cost of air tickets was very high and un-affordable for the Chamber.

4. Mr. Wali Mohammad, the appellant was also present in the office who was called to know if he had any objection to the proposed early hearing. Mr. Wali Mohammad did not show any resistance, therefore, after his negotiation with Nawab Ayyaz Khan Jogezeai, a notable from the area and an MPA of Balochistan Assembly and Mr. Wali Mohammad made a statement before me that he was not interested to pursue the appeal and withdraws the same.

5. Accordingly, in view of Mr. Wali Mohammad's statement, the instant appeal is hereby dismissed as withdrawn.
